IF YOU MOVED WITHIN THE COUNTY ON OR **BEFORE** 15 DAY DATE SHOWN ABOVE AND DID NOT RE-REGISTER AT YOUR NEW ADDRESS, YOU MAY VOTE AND RE-REGISTER FOR FUTURE ELECTIONS EITHER AT THE COUNTY ELECTIONS OFFICE OR AT THE POLLING PLACE WHERE YOU NOW LIVE. IF YOU MOVED **AFTER** THE 15 DAY DATE SHOWN ABOVE, YOU MAY VOTE A PROVISIONAL BALLOT AT THE POLLING PLACE FOR YOUR CURRENT **OR** PREVIOUS ADDRESS **FOR THIS ELECTION ONLY**, THEN YOU MUST RE-REGISTER AND VOTE AT YOUR NEW ADDRESS FOR ANY FUTURE ELECTIONS.

NOTICE OF NEW ELECTION LAW

NOW ANYONE CAN VOTE BY MAIL PERMANENTLY

Section 3201 of the California Elections Code allows any voter to apply for *permanent* vote-by-mail voter status effective January 1, 2002. *Permanent* vote-by-mail voters automatically receive a ballot in the mail within 29 days before every election in which they are eligible to vote. **This new law is designed to make voting more convenient for everyone.** People who work out of town, or work on 24-hour shifts, or have a disability, or just don't like to stand in line at the polls can now vote at home – *permanently*.
